This NGO basically was started to redress the problem being faced by the weaker section of Madanpur related modern education, but soon our services extended to all other rural areas also. As an NGO, we have been providing our services for the past 5 years in the field of education among the different sections of society, with a special focus on the education of girl child. As we talk about providing modern education, we would like to mention our inspiration, Sir Syed Ahmad Khan, who fought a long battle to provide modern education to the weaker section of society.

After analysing all the possible problems faced by the weaker sections in providing quality education to their new generations, we have launched a series of programmes like talent hunt exams based on OMR, an educational awareness programme, and counselling sessions for academic careers. In 2021, we started a free online coaching programme (Sir Syed Coaching & Guidance Centre) for aspirants who want to take admission in central universities in India. In the first batch, about 60 students have cracked the entrance exams of many central universities like AMU, BHU, Jamia, and many more. We have a team of well versed persons inter alia like public speaking, career counselling and many more who have helped the needy persons to acquire the right knowledge and walk through the correct door in order to achieve what is best for them.Our work has made a positive impact on the targeted sections, and seeing the progress, we are willing and will continue working in a more disciplined manner to make this society a better place for the social minorities.

We have been conducting this exam since 2018 which has helped the students of rural India not only to know the competitive environment but has also encouraged them to take more and more part in the modern education. This exam is conducted on a nominal fees of Rs 100 only which gives every single student opportunity to take part, as a result the number of students taking part has been significantly increased from 200 in year 2018 to 1000 in 2023. Today, we can proudly say that our initiative has not only opened a door for the minorities but has created a pathway to their sparkling dreams which surely will lead them to a world free of ignorance. And we hope that these numbers will keep rising and we intend to continue the process for more betterment of the students in rural India.











SUPER 20 (2020, 2022 & 2023)

Series of Super 20 named exam is the successor of Madanpur Talent Hunt Exam- 2019. In this series of Super 20 exam, we focus on the top 20 scorers and offer them free counselling sessions with our faculty members which helps them clarify their objective of choosinga field for their academic career. This exam had played a vital role for us in choosing talented but financially weak students so we can help them out in every possible manner. The outcomes have been better and better by every passing year, for instance 500 students appeared in the first season & in the third season the number crossed the milestone of 1000 students. This series has helped us in creating a competitive environment for the students in rural centres and we intend to keep working in a more enthusiastic manner for the betterment of the students of backward areas.







EDUCATION AWARENESS PROGRAM

Moving forward we found that even after our progressive work some sections were still not coming forward to change their condition and step into a literate and more civilized society so, we started analysing flaws which have had become a hurdle in doing so. So, after observing the problem being faced by the students and their parents in continuing the studies, we decided to launch an awareness program to make the people aware of the Importance of Education and the problem being faced by them along with the society due to Lack of Education. In the series of Educational Awareness Program, the first program was launched in 2018 themed as The Importance of Education.

SIR SYED COACHING AND GUIDANCE CENTRE

In order to redress the problem in a least way we started a free coaching and guidance centre to help the financially backward student achieve their goal and started giving them coaching and guidance related the centre universities like AMU, JMI & BHU. Firstly we started this coaching in Madanpur (a village in the district of Deoria, U.P.) in a rental unfurnished classroom with about 15-20 students. But with in a month, we decided to convert this offline coaching into online so that every aspirant from every place can join our coaching. As a result, we now have more than hundreds of students enrolled in many prestigious institutions and trying their best to achieve their goals make this society a better place.
